We were also able to represent Pakistan successfully at an international day event carried after 3 years in Berlin International School.

During the year we also coordinated with people from various walks of life including, students, thinktanks, journalists and office bearers at various levels to further augment the ties.

The Consulate General of Pakistan in Frankfurt's jurisdiction is marked by two unique elements.

First it serves more than 75% of Pakistani community in Germany and second, it remains focal in facilitating Pakistani traders' participation in various trade exhibitions.

During March-June 2022, the Consulate's activities remained centred on the two aspects.

In collaboration with Pakistani lady doctors, a "Children's Health Seminar" was organised in June for dissemination of basic and relevant information to an exclusive audience of Pakistani ladies. The seminar followed last year's which focussed on women health.

The Consulate's Help Desk facilitated more than 400 Pakistanis, during March - June 2022 in filing their online applications through Government of Pakistan's various portals.

It remains a very important platform viz. for those Pakistanis who require assistance in data handling on these portals.

On trade front, Frankfurt's famous home textile exhibition "Heimtextil" was held in June after a long gap - thanks to the easing out of COVID-19 restrictions.

The Consulate General, in collaboration with the Trade Development Authority of Pakistan, facilitated around 44 Pakistani traders who participated in the exhibition.

The Pakistani stalls were among the topmost visited ones in the Heimtextil, which fetched thousands of visitors during the four days of the exhibition.

And finally, it was indeed a deeply inspiring experience to see the Pakistani community's philanthropic penchant during the fundraising for Indus hospital.

During the period we interacted with people at various levels within the Pakistani community as well as the hosts to further develop our community outreach and strengthen bilateral relations.

Issues regarding Pakistan-German Relations were discussed during the meeting.





Guests enjoyed the enlightening talk by Prof. Salima Hashmi and scintillating music by Ustad Ashraf Sharif Khan and Friends.






INTERNATIONAL DAY

The Pakistani community based philanthropist organisation will donate equipment and funds to Indus Hospital in Paksitan for free health care facilities to the needy.







Trade activity Heimtextil 2022 was held at Frankfurt from 21-24 June, 2022. Around 130 Pakistani exhibitors belonging to the manufacture and marketing of home textile sector of Pakistan participated in the exhibition.





Of these 44 exhibiting companies participated under patronage of TDAP. Consul General Mr. Zahid Hussain visited Pakistani exhibitors, he offered full assistance and expressed hope that participation in the exhibition by Pakistani companies will help in increasing Pakistani exports to Germany.
